In 1977, Clifford E. Ripley, then Palm Beach County Schools' Assistant Superintendent, called together several key administrators from public, private and parochial schools, and proposed the idea of a dinner to recognize outstanding scholastic achievement in high school seniors throughout the county. The Scholastic Achievement Foundation was born!

The recognition took the form of an elegant dinner held in the Venetian Ballroom of the Breakers Hotel in Palm Beach, meant to give each student a memory to last a lifetime. In 2017, 178 students attended and were honored. In 2017, we were also honored to have Tiffany Kenney, News Anchor, Channel 25 News as our Mistress of Ceremonies.

The Foundation began presenting sponsored scholarships, in the amount of \$1000 to selected students who attended the dinner. In addition, we now present a four-year, full tuition scholarship to a student to each of the following universities: Lynn University, Florida Atlantic University, Palm Beach Atlantic University, and Palm Beach State College.

For over 40 years the achievements of more than 4200 students have been recognized at our dinners with over 350 of these students receiving scholarships. Our continuing mission is to honor these outstanding scholars.
